We have a limited number of full and partial scholarships to award to applicants. An application *submission* does not guarantee a scholarship to camp. If your child is not awarded a scholarship or is awarded a partial scholarship, any tuition balance is due by June 1.

All scholarship applicants will first be considered for the annual Sweetness of Mary Scholarship. Next, applicants will be considered for our 2022 named scholarships. Finally, applicants will be considered for a Junior Camp Scholarship. There are several to be awarded from this category. Please read about the scholarships on the main scholarship page.

Part I - Camper's Information - Cover letter

In a simple cover letter, please include the following information:

- Applicant's first and last name
- Age of applicant
- Primary fife and drum corps and instrument or drum major
- Years involved with fife and drum and years involved with primary corps

Part II - Essay

Choose **one** of the following to answer. The essay should be no more than a page or two and should be answered by the camper, **not** an adult. If the applicant is younger and cannot yet type, a legible handwritten essay may be scanned and attached to an email.

1. Describe the positive influence that fife and drum has had on your life.
2. Why do you want to go to fife and drum camp and what do you hope to learn?
3. Describe three things you are proud of as a member of a fife and drum corps.
4. Write about what fife and drum means to you.

Part III - Please answer the following questions. The second question is *optional*.

1) Have you done any volunteer work for the fife and drum community? Please describe, especially noting work done outside your primary corps but please include this as well. This should be answered by the **camper**.

2) Tell us about any special circumstances you might have that make a scholarship especially helpful to you and/or your family. This is optional and may be answered by a parent/guardian.
